As we prepare for the arrival of our Year 7 students, we are actively working on various aspects, including curriculum development and the physical classroom spaces dedicated to Year 7.



The Stage 4 curriculum, as prescribed by the New South Wales Standards Authority (NESA), encompasses a wide range of subjects. Naturally, English, Mathematics, and Science receive significant attention in terms of allocation of time. Additionally, our curriculum includes a stand-alone course on Religion, emphasising Catholic values, traditions, and spiritual life. Students will also engage with History, Geography, Music, Visual Art, Personal Development, Physical Education (PDHPE), and Language (German).

Our incoming Year 7 students come from diverse educational backgrounds, each with unique experiences. Therefore, one of our primary objectives in Year 7 curriculum development is to consolidate their prior learning and then extend student understanding in each of the disciplines with specific teaching strategies best suited for the course and students.

Our dedicated teaching staff, along with our Leaders of Learning are structuring the learning environment to ensure that every student thrives in the classroom. Teachers will employ differentiated instruction techniques to cater to the individual levels of achievement and understanding among our students.

In addition to curriculum development, we have designed our new classroom spaces to facilitate classroom integration and student movement within each course. This enables teachers to collaborate across classrooms, offer diverse activities that accommodate students' varying levels of proficiency, and promote deeper understanding. The layout and functionality of these refurbished classrooms are a testament to our commitment to cross-class collaboration and flexible learning, which are integral components of our Year 7 teaching and learning strategies.
